



Record IB and ALP Results for Island School in 2018

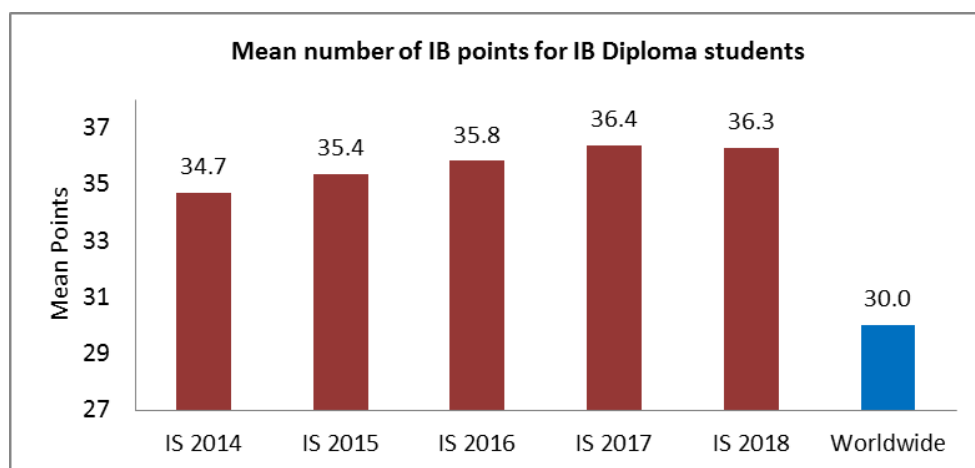
This year a total of 5 students achieved the maximum IB Diploma score of 45 points and six students achieved a maximum of 3 Distinction * grades in the Applied Learning Pathway.

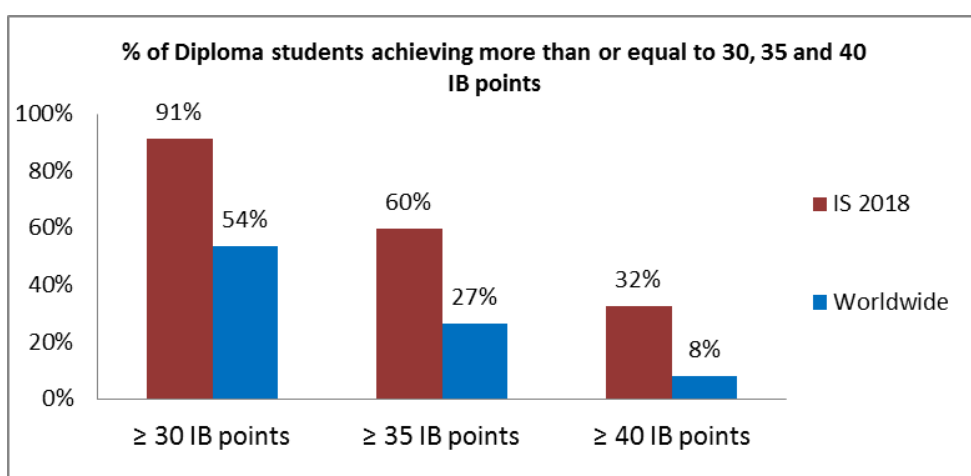
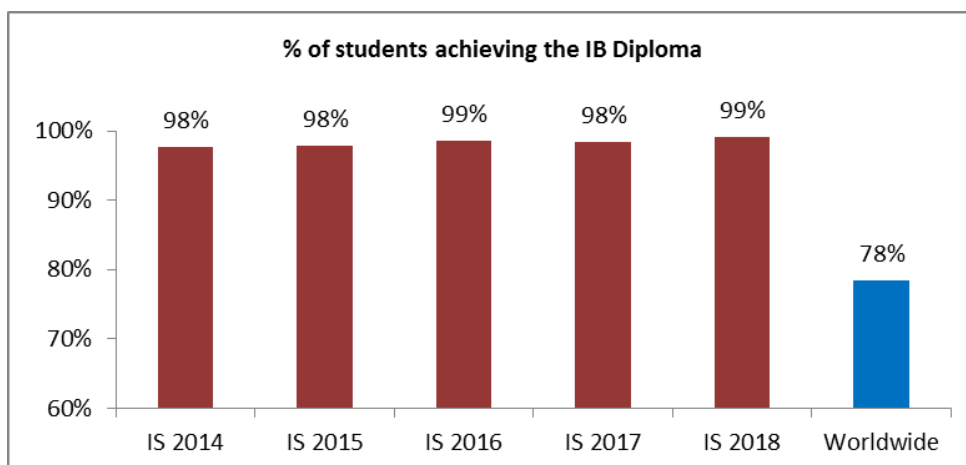
For the IB results the average score is 36.3 with a 99% pass rate and an impressive 32.5% of students achieving over 40 points.

The students with a maximum score of 45 points are: Isabella Chan, Stephanie Cheung, Chak Kei Lau, Julia Mulrooney & Vivien Hei Man Lam. There were also three students with 44 points. They were Quentin Mak, Kylie Tsang and Thomas Yik.

For the Applied Learning Pathway 65% of all grades were at Distinction * and the overall pass rate was 99%. The students with all Distinction * grades were Kelly Beaumont, Mwenda Chisulo, Ester Clement, Reina Kim, Jack Dale, Daniel Meerovitsch, Aisha Bhatia and Sean Leung.

We congratulate all of the students on their results. As the first cohort to graduate from Sha Tin Wai after the move this is an especially proud moment for the school community.
