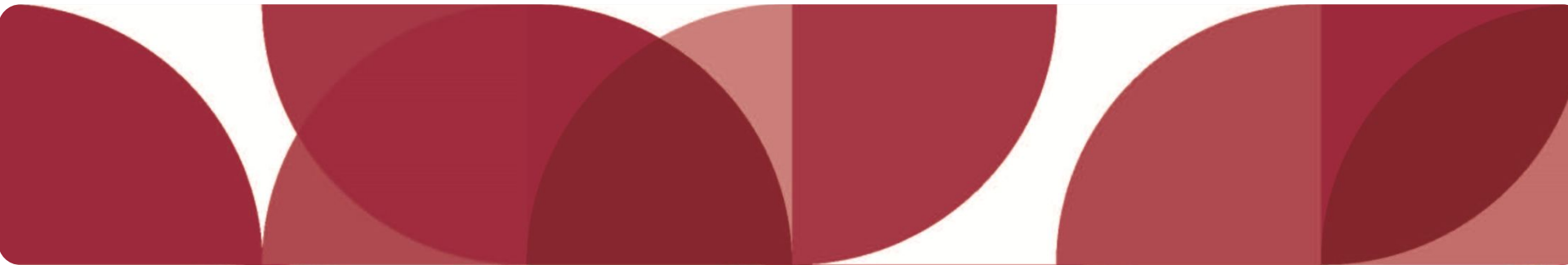

Key Points to Note

- ❖ Student Day starts on Wednesday, 18 August 2021
- ❖ On the day, all NEW students and their parents will attend a Welcome Assembly from 7.55am to 9am in the School Hall at Sha Tin Wai (Year 7,8 & 12) or Tai Wai (Year 9-11) from 7:55am. Students will be sent to their Form rooms at 8.30 but parents may remain until 9am.
- ❖ The school day will end at 12.35pm on Wednesday, and according to the timetable on Thursday and Friday of Orientation week.
- ❖ Kwoon Chung School Bus service commences for registered users from Wednesday
- ❖ Students in Years 7-11 should wear their PE Kit to school on Wednesday and their normal school uniform for the rest of the week.
- ❖ Students should bring an Octopus card to swipe in. Students might want to consider applying for a Personalised Octopus (with name and photo printed on the Octopus) [online](#). Students 12 years and older can add a "Student Status" to their personalised cards. Students will be allocated a time on the first day to have their Octopus cards registered with the General Office.
- ❖ Students should bring a water bottle which can be refilled at bottle filling stations.
