

## IB Bilingual Diploma

### School-Supported Self-Taught Language A

#### Information and Questionnaire for Students

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IB DP) school-supported self-taught (SSST) programme is a literature-based course that allows Years 12 and 13 students to take two languages in the category of 'Language A', offering the opportunity to obtain the IB Bilingual Diploma.

The DP Language A SSST course aims to develop an understanding of the techniques involved in literary criticism and enhance the ability to form independent literary judgments to support ideas. SSST courses are offered at Standard Level (SL) only.

*Being a self-taught student offers a unique opportunity to study the literature of a language that may not be offered at your school as a taught subject. A certain level of autonomy is expected, for example, you will be asked to develop a list of literary works and a timeline. You will also be expected to autonomously administer the 150 hours required for the study of the course.*

The SSST programme is designed as an option for students who are able to demonstrate they:

- Are self-motivated and independent learners.
- Have an interest in literature in their first/target language.
- Have a high standard of proficiency in the first/target language (in all four skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking).
- Are able to read and write to an academic proficiency in the first/target language (a benchmark test will be taken prior to enrollment in the programme).
- Are able to commit to additional tutorial support in the target language. Your school is able to assist with this.
